

Daily Readings

Monday	Read Ephesians 1:15-16. Who do you thank God for? Whose faith is a blessing to you? Whose love for others is an inspiration to you? Thank God for those people in your life today. Pray that you will be such a person to others as well.
Tuesday	Read Ephesians 1:17-19a. Pray this prayer for yourself, and then for another in your life. How does one grow in wisdom to know God better? How have the eyes of your heart been enlightened to see the hope that Jesus gives you? The glorious inheritance of his people is a life of love that never ends. How does that promise sustain you in hope?
Wednesday	Read Ephesians 1:19-23. The same power that raised Jesus from death to life is at work in us today. That power is the power of God's Holy Spirit. Jesus is the one who is given all authority and power over all things, and He is the one we claim as Lord. Knowing this, in prayer go before the throne of Grace, with both the needs and the praise on your heart.
Thursday	Read John 17:1-9. In a healthy relationship, you want others to speak well of those you love: You want to bring glory to them, by what you do. Jesus loves God his Father, and God the Father loves Jesus, the Son. How do you seek to glorify the name of the Lord in your life? Jesus said eternal life is this: to know God. In love, God invites us to share his life! Jesus prays that we who love God would grow in knowing him more! Pray today that God would show you more of his character.
Friday	Read John 17:15-19. In Jesus' prayer, he prays that we would be protected while in the world, but he doesn't pray that we just be removed from the world and its troubles. His prayer is that we be sanctified (made holy) by the truth. God's word is that truth and it is Jesus, (the word of God in the flesh) who offers himself to sanctify us (make us holy). Confess your sins to God, trust his promise of Grace from 1 John 1:8-9.
Saturday	Read John 17:22-26. Jesus' prayer is that the Love that God has for Jesus, his Son, would also be in us. Jesus wants us to know that God loves us in that same powerful way! Having been made clean in Christ's sacrifice, our lives become vessels for God's love, even as we receive it. Jesus wants us to know the Father's love, and His love. Read and repeat verse 26 in prayer. Hear Jesus' voice praying this petition, about YOU!
