Daily Readings

Monday	Read Psalm 78. How does this Psalm help us understand the kind of spiritual legacy we are called to pass down to the next generation? How is God leading you to make a difference in the next generation?
Tuesday	Deuteronomy 30:11-20. What kind of legacy did Moses' want Israel to leave behind? How were they to impact the next generation?
Wednesday	Read Mark 9:2-8. In the transfiguration, Jesus reveals His glory to James, John, and Peter. What is striking to you about the story of the transfiguration? What have been some moments in your life when God has revealed Himself to you in a powerful way? In what ways do those moments help you to listen to Jesus in ordinary life?
Thursday	Read Revelation 1:9-18. What similarities do you see between this appearance of Jesus to John and the transfiguration? What does Jesus' reveal about Himself in these encounters? What is similar about the human response? How is God expanding our vision of who He is in these encounters?
Friday	Read Matthew 7:21-29. How do these teachings of Jesus encourage or challenge you when you think about the legacy you are leaving behind for the next generation?
Saturday	Read Mark 10:13-16. Why was Jesus mad at his disciples? What was wrong with their attitude about children? How do children teach us about God's Kingdom? What have you learned about God and yourself through children?



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
