Not counting Jesus, who do you think is most famous for their death? Why?

Get started today by thinking about why Jesus died or why he had to die. If someone asked a Christian why Jesus died, what do you think different Christians might say? Try to make a list.

One of the main things that the Bible connects with Jesus' death is forgiveness. Jesus even spoke words of forgiveness as he was dying. **Read Luke 23:33-34**.

- Who was Jesus talking about in these verses?
- What seems important to you about this?
- What does this situation tell us about the extent of Jesus' forgiveness?

Jesus taught his followers to understand his hard-to-understand death in light of things they already knew from the Old Testament. Long ago, God had given the prophet Isaiah a vision or insight into the kind of leader, servant, and Savior he would send. **Read Isaiah 52:13-53:12** to hear this vision.

- How would you describe this "servant" and what he would do?
- What does this passage teach us to believe about Jesus and his death?

Read Psalm 103:8-12 for another Old Testament picture of the character of God's forgiveness.

- What does this passage say about God's forgiveness?
- How far is the east from the west?
- Do you ever struggle to believe that God would remove your sin from you that completely?

In today's message we learned to say, "Because he died...I am forgiven." Take a moment to think, perhaps just quietly, about the guilt you need to be forgiven for. Then as a group say out loud, "Because he died, I am forgiven."

When and how can you repeat or remember this during your week?

Read Jesus' instruction about prayer and forgiveness in Matthew 6:9-15, and pray the Lord's prayer together.
