Daily Readings

Monday	Read John 6:1-9. When we serve Jesus with whatever small offerings we have he can do great things with them. Mother Theresa was famous for doing "small things with great love." Is Jesus leading you to any action like this?
Tuesday	Read John 6:10-15. (Review also Deuteronomy 18:15 and John 1:21 regarding Jewish hope for "the Prophet" like Moses.) Pray that God will help you see how Jesus fulfills our best hopes.
Wednesday	Read John 6:16-24. John tells us that the disciples of Jesus were willing to take him into the boat. Have you ever welcomed Jesus in a time of fear?
Thursday	Read John 6:25-40. Jesus calls himself the true bread from heaven. Are you seeking true nourishment and satisfaction anywhere else? Why is Jesus the <i>true</i> bread for the life of the world?
Friday	Read John 6:41-60. Pray for understanding of this "hard teaching" and that God will lead more people to faith and eternal life.
aturday	Read John 6:61-70. Some disciples left Jesus (verse 66) and some were strengthened in their faith (v. 68). Pray God will help your heart embrace the unique power of salvation that Jesus brings.
