#### What the Blind Man Sees

Things I'd like to remember about today's message...

Regular habits of private Bible reading strengthen our relationship with God and teach us how to follow Jesus. In addition to the thematic exercise above, you can use this guide each week to lead you through relevant sections of the Bible.

### **Group Discussion Guide**

#### CONNECT

Who is the most famous celebrity you've ever met or seen in person?

• How might you be called to act differently in light of the cross?

#### **LEARN AND APPLY**

This Sunday was a holiday known as "Palm Sunday," because of the palm branches that were laid on the road by which Jesus entered Jerusalem - a symbol of honoring him as king. **Read Mark 11:1-11** to learn the story.

- Where and when is Jesus acclaimed as king today?
- There are many different ways that Jesus is understood and misunderstood today, just as then. What different understandings of Jesus do people have today?

In the message this week we learned that Jesus taught his first disciples what to expect when he finally entered Jerusalem as king; that he would be arrested and killed. He also taught what this meant for them as his disciples.

- Read Mark 8:31-38. What does Jesus say about following him?
- Read Mark 9:30-37. What does Jesus have to explain to his followers?
- Read Mark 10:32-45. How does Jesus apply his own example to the lives of his disciples?

Discuss the teaching and way of Jesus with your group.

• How might you need to think differently in light of the cross?

#### PRAY AND APPLY

Share your prayer needs with one another. In addition, remember the two blind men we learned about this week who were healed by Jesus. Pray that God would open our eyes to see and live by the hope of the cross of Jesus.
