LEARN & APPLY

The Exodus is the central story of the Old Testament. God's people were enslaved in Egypt, and the Lord worked mightily to liberate them, via his servant, Moses. It is a stunning saga.

Moses is the earthly star of this liberation drama.

- How would you describe this complex man?

God called Moses into service, from tending sheep in Arabia. How?

- What did God say to him? How did Moses respond?
- How might He call people today?

The Lord tried many ways to get Pharaoh to release the slaves. Name a few of them. The struggle between Pharaoh and Moses is a kind of proxy fight between God and the false gods of Egypt.

- Why is it so hard?
