



## CHILDREN'S MINISTRY INTERN

### Job Classification

Part-time, paid internship.

Community of Grace Lutheran Church ([CGLC](#)) in White Bear Lake, Minnesota is seeking a Children's Ministry Intern. This position is an exceptional opportunity for a current ministry student to join a healthy, teaching congregation in the northeast metro area of Minneapolis/St. Paul. The program will run approximately ten months and be considered a top-priority commitment along with the students' schoolwork. Interns should expect to work at least 150 hours each semester. There will also be intern cohort gatherings and training opportunities.

### Internship Description

Our Children's Ministry Intern will gain experience in engaging children from birth to sixth grade with Bible-based content. Duties include leading groups of varying ages, curriculum and lesson planning, event planning and coordination, volunteer coordinating, resource management, and parent communication and engagement. The ideal candidate has experience working with pre-K and elementary-aged children and their families. Responsibilities include:

- Participating in creating pre-produced video and audio content.
- Exploring ways to engage families through social media.
- Tailoring curriculum lessons to fit our program needs.
- Assisting in coordinating special events.
- Assisting in parent and volunteer communications.
- Responsibilities can be tailored to the intern's goals and gifting.

### Preferred Qualifications

- Must have at least basic knowledge of video and audio software.
- Lead elementary large group at least one Sunday each month.
- Lead/assist in the pre-K wing at least one Sunday each month.
- On-call substitute for Sunday school teachers.
- Participate in special events.
- Background in theological studies is a plus.
- Some experience in video production and/or graphic design is a plus.
- Minimum one-year commitment.
- Should demonstrate a deep and growing relationship with Jesus Christ.
