

ON-SITE WORSHIP PRODUCTION INTERN

Job Classification

Part-time, paid internship.

Community of Grace Lutheran Church (CGLC) in White Bear Lake, Minnesota is seeking an On-site Worship Production Intern. This position is an exceptional opportunity for a current ministry student to join a healthy, teaching congregation in the northeast metro area of Minneapolis/St. Paul. The program will run approximately ten months and be considered a top priority commitment along with the students' schoolwork. Interns should expect to work at least 150 hours each semester. There will also be intern cohort gatherings and training opportunities.

Internship Description

Our On-site Worship Production Intern will gain skills and experiences relevant to producing in-person worship services, including technical direction (video switcher and robotic camera operation), audio (mixing live sound), graphics operation, and ensuring all technical elements of the service run smoothly. The ideal candidate would have experience mixing bands live. Responsibilities include:

- Video technical direction.
- Mixing live audio (including rehearsals, set-up, and tear-down)
- Graphics operation (ProPresenter 7).

Preferred Qualifications

- Experience in live audio (not required).
- Thursday night rehearsals (6 p.m.-9 p.m.; including set-up and tear-down)
- Sunday services three times each month (6:30 a.m.-12 p.m.).
- Minimum one-year commitment.
- Should demonstrate a deep and growing relationship with Jesus Christ.

Supervision

This position reports to the Contemporary Worship Leader and Worship Technology Coordinator.

CGLC is a spirit-filled congregation that believes investing in the future of the church is vital. At its core, the church is committed to the gospel of Jesus Christ as reflected in our mission *To Be and Make Disciples* of Jesus through worship, groups, and serving.
