This position is an exceptional opportunity for a current ministry student to join a healthy, teaching congregation in the northeast metro area of Minneapolis/St. Paul. The program will run approximately ten months and be considered a top-priority commitment along with the students' schoolwork. Interns should expect to work at least 150 hours each semester. There will also be intern cohort gatherings and training opportunities.

Internship Description

Our Studio Production Intern will focus on pre-producing audio and video content. We have a sweet studio space with plenty of equipment to let your imagination run wild! The ideal candidate will have experience in video, audio, and lighting and will want to spend lots of time creating and playing while keeping deadlines. Responsibilities include:

- Producing custom videos.
- Producing the Grace People Podcast.
- Recording and mixing audio (i.e., acoustic tracks or full-band recordings).

Preferred Qualifications

- Must have at least basic knowledge of video and audio software.
- Sunday in-person worship attendance three times each month.
- Minimum one-year commitment with flexible hours.
- Should demonstrate a deep and growing relationship with Jesus Christ.
