

WORSHIP LEADING INTERN

Job Classification

Part-time, paid internship.

Community of Grace Lutheran Church (CGLC) in White Bear Lake, Minnesota is seeking a Worship Leading Intern. This position is an exceptional opportunity for a current ministry student to join a healthy, teaching congregation in the northeast metro area of Minneapolis/St. Paul. The program will run approximately ten months and be considered a top-priority commitment along with the students' schoolwork. Interns should expect to work at least 150 hours each semester. There will also be intern cohort gatherings and training opportunities.

Internship Description

Our Worship Leading Intern will receive dynamic coaching in leading a congregation through modern/contemporary worship services, including developing their "why" of worship leading, rehearsing a band, leading a congregation, and gaining necessary relevant administrative skills. The ideal candidate will have experience leading worship. Responsibilities include:

- Sunday worship leading.
- Refuge band leading (student ministries).
- Musical Directing (leading the band).
- Scheduling.
- Specific responsibilities will be tailored to the intern's goals and gifting.

Preferred Qualifications

- Vocal and instrumental proficiency to lead a congregation is required (would be open to a vocal leader who does not play an instrument).
- Thursday evening rehearsals, Sunday services three times each month.
- Wednesday night student ministries worship two times each month.
- Minimum one-year commitment.
- Should demonstrate a deep and growing relationship with Jesus Christ.

Supervision

This position reports to the Contemporary Worship Leader.

Church Overview

CGLC is a spirit-filled congregation that believes investing in the future of the church is vital. At its core, the church is committed to the gospel of Jesus Christ as reflected in our mission *To Be and Make Disciples* of Christ through worship, small groups, and serving.

The church is part of Lutheran Congregations in Mission for Christ (<u>LCMC</u>) and the Association of Renewal Churches (<u>ARC</u>). Being Lutheran is not a requirement; however, interns will learn to interpret and lead ministry through a basic Lutheran theological lens.
