Job Description

To assist the Director of Student Ministries in leading student ministry programming for high school-age youth and coordinating service opportunities with our key mission partners to benefit the entire congregation. This position will foster Christian community through building relationships with young people that strengthen their commitment to the church and growth in faith in Jesus Christ while providing multigenerational opportunities for serving our community with the love of Jesus Christ.

- Preach and teach to a student audience regularly.
- Plan and implement faith and fellowship events focusing on high school and young adult activities.

- Perform other duties as assigned.
