

STUDENT MINISTRIES INTERN

Job Classification

Part-time, paid internship.

Community of Grace Lutheran Church ([CGLC](#)) in White Bear Lake, Minnesota is seeking a Student Ministries Intern. This position is an exceptional opportunity for a current ministry student to join a healthy, teaching congregation in the northeast metro area of Minneapolis/St. Paul. The program will run approximately nine months and be considered a top-priority commitment along with the students' schoolwork. Interns should expect to work at least 150 hours each semester, including intern cohort gatherings and training opportunities.

Internship Description

Our Student Ministries Intern should be passionate about Jesus and leading youth to love him. The ideal candidate is someone looking for an opportunity to learn and practice ministry in a safe and nurturing environment as they discern a call into vocational ministry. Responsibilities include:

- Assist with plans and leadership of Refuge (Wednesday evening youth ministry program).
 - This could consist of planning a message series, leading a game, substituting for a small group leader, being present on the platform, set-up, and tear-down, etc.
- Give the message at Refuge at least one Wednesday each month.
- Assist in coordinating special events (primarily on weekends).
- Connect with students through social media, texting, and personal contact.
- Assist with social media correspondence, posts, and updates.
- Capture photos and videos at Refuge and special events.

Expectations

- Proven leadership and spiritual maturity (please provide references).
- Attend worship at least three Sundays each month.
- Be present Wednesdays from 5:00 p.m.-8:30 p.m. during the school year.
- Participate in summer special events and all-staff required events.
- Weekly check-in with Student Ministries Director and bi-monthly Core Team meetings.
- Minimum one academic-year commitment (excluding summer interns).
- Should demonstrate a deep and growing relationship with Jesus Christ.

Preferred Qualifications

- Preference will be given to those with prior experience in Youth Ministry.
- Some experience in video production and/or graphic design is a plus.

CGLC is a spirit-filled congregation that believes investing in the future of the church is vital. At its core, the church is committed to the gospel of Jesus Christ as reflected in our mission *To Be and Make Disciples* of Jesus through worship, groups, and serving.
