



WORSHIP LEADING INTERN

Job Classification

Part-time, paid internship.

Community of Grace Lutheran Church ([CGLC](#)) in White Bear Lake, Minnesota is seeking a Worship Leading Intern. This position is an exceptional opportunity for a current ministry student to join a healthy, teaching congregation in the northeast metro area of Minneapolis/St. Paul. The program will run approximately nine months and be considered a top-priority commitment along with the students' schoolwork. Interns should expect to work 150 hours each semester, including intern cohort gatherings and training opportunities.

Internship Description

Our Worship Leading Intern will receive dynamic coaching in leading a congregation through modern/contemporary worship services, including developing their "why" of worship leading, rehearsing a band, leading a congregation, and gaining necessary relevant administrative skills. The ideal candidate will have experience leading worship. Responsibilities include:

- Leading worship on Sunday mornings (once per month).
- Leading worship for student ministries on Wednesdays (once per month).
- Musical Directing (leading the band).
- Designing services and scheduling volunteers through Planning Center.
- Specific responsibilities will be tailored to the intern's goals and gifting.

Expectations

- Vocal proficiency to lead a congregation.
- Minimum one academic-year commitment (excluding summer interns).
- Should demonstrate a deep and growing relationship with Jesus Christ.

Preferred Qualification

- Instrumental proficiency (i.e., piano, guitar)

Supervision

This position reports to the Contemporary Worship Leader.
